CL Trucking will start work on the watermain replacement project in the Adacraft neighborhood next week. This letter will provide additional detail on their construction schedule.

There are three phases to the project:

1. Water main construction.
2. Water service installation and connection to your house.
3. Asphalt removal and repaving.

There are nearly three miles of streets and watermain in the Adacraft neighborhood and construction will last through the middle of October. We have enclosed two maps that show the sequencing of construction for the first two phases.

1. Water Main Construction - The first map shows the schedule for the water main installation. During this phase, the contractor will excavate a trench roughly six feet deep and install the water main. The watermain will be installed on the north or west sides of the road roughly 11 feet from the edge of the pavement. It will be backfilled immediately after the water main is installed. If you are on the north or west side of the street, a portion of your driveway will also be removed. It will be replaced with temporary gravel to allow access to your driveway.
2. Water Service Installation – Your water service will be replaced with a new copper service from the new main up to your property line. The second map shows the schedule for placing the water service lines and connecting your house to the new the water main. When they make the connection to your house, you will be without water for up to four hours. After the connection is made, we recommend that you run water through an outdoor spigot for a few minutes to flush the new water service line. This map also contains dates for replacement of any driveways that were removed. After the concrete is poured, we recommend that you park in the street for a week to let the concrete cure. You will be notified before your driveway is poured, so your car won't be trapped in your garage.
3. All of the street pavement will be removed as well, but this won't take place until September. The pavement will be removed with a cold-milling machine and the first layer of asphalt will be placed later in September, and the final layer will be placed around the middle of October.
