

In a conversation yesterday (05/06/2021) with Steve Groenenboom, a Project Engineer from Moore & Bruggink about some questions asked about the coming water line replacement in Adacraft Commons. These items were reviewed by Steve and he has corrected or clarified as needed.

- 1) The new water line replacement will be dug into the side of the road that has the Fire Hydrants.  
Construction can go up to the city right-of-way on your property. This is 33 feet from the centerline of the street. Many people are not aware of this, this is your actual property line. Move anything you want to save (plants, ornaments, etc.) that are not on your property side of the line.
- 2) If you have underground sprinkler in this area, **Mark each of Them**. My suggestion is to go to Home Depot and purchase “15 in. Irrigation Flags (10-Pack)” for around \$1.55. At the Kentwood Store 108 in stock Aisle 12, Bay EC2. Place a flag at **Each** sprinkler head in the affected area and take a picture so you remember where they are. I would also mark each head NEAR the affected area, just in case. The heads will be reconnected by the construction company after the dig is filled back in. There will be a time period where the lines cut will not be usable until they are repaired. i.e. cannot use that sprinkler zone. Depending on your home configuration several zones could be affected.
- 3) Underground (dog/animal) fence should not be in this area and it will not be replaced. It is fairly easy to repair if you know where it is. Please let the construction people know where it is. They may try to splice it back together, but this is ultimately the homeowner’s responsibility.
- 4) New underground water lines will be provided and reconnected up to your existing line from the house. The underground line between the house and the property line is the homeowner’s responsibility. If you have any special considerations, call the project engineers listed below to discuss.
- 5) Driveways on the waterline side will be dug up and replaced up to the right-of-way as mentioned above. There should already be a RED DOT on your driveway showing where it will be removed to.
- 6) On the Water Service Connection Schedule, the dates for Area 6 and 7 were missed.
  - a. Tie-Ins & Services: 8/10 to 8/25
  - b. Concrete Driveways and Restorations: 8/10 to 8/25
